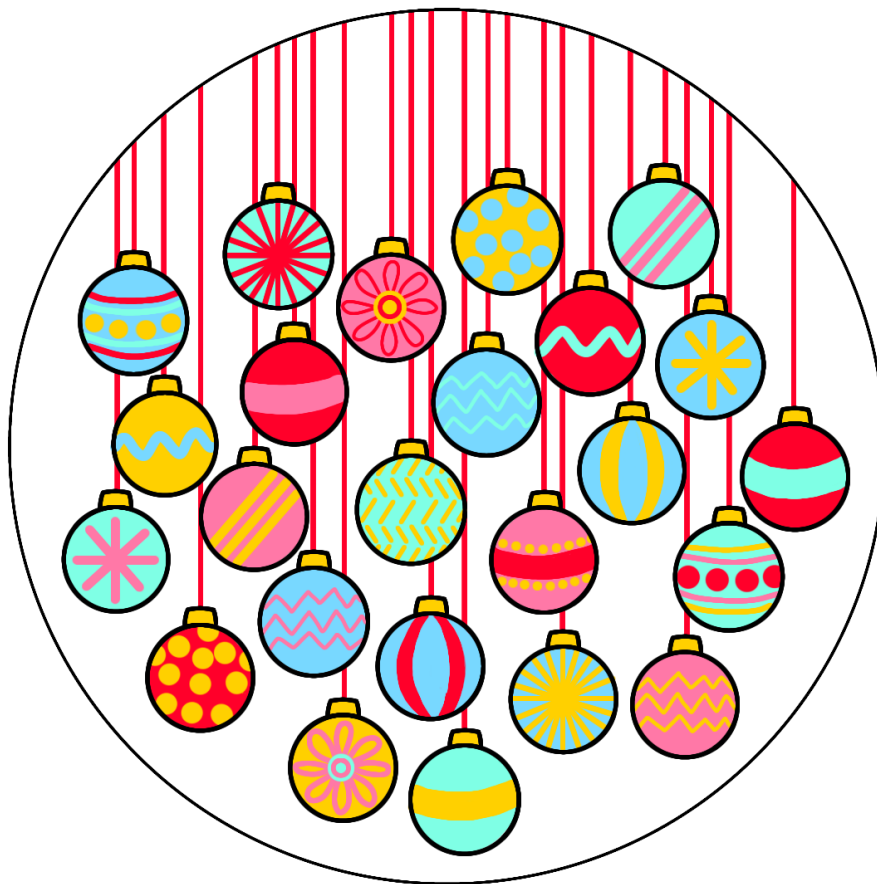


Bauble Advent

Embroidery Template

24 Christmas baubles to stitch, one for each day as we
countdown to Santa's visit.



All you need to do is print out the template, trace it onto your fabric, and then have fun stitching a bauble every day. You'll be able to decorate the baubles using whichever stitches and thread colours you like! There are no rules! Its all about having fun!

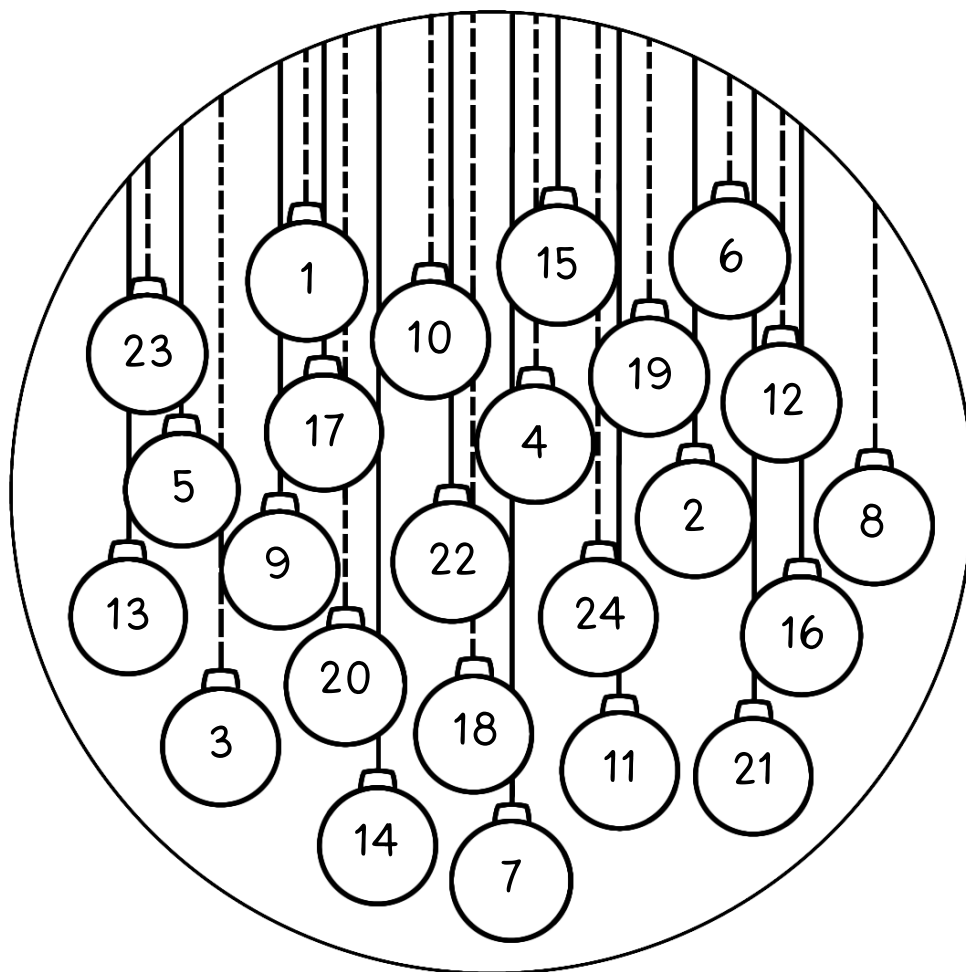
The Template

Use these black and white pattern templates to trace onto your fabric. I have provided the pattern sized to fit a 5" or a 7" hoop.

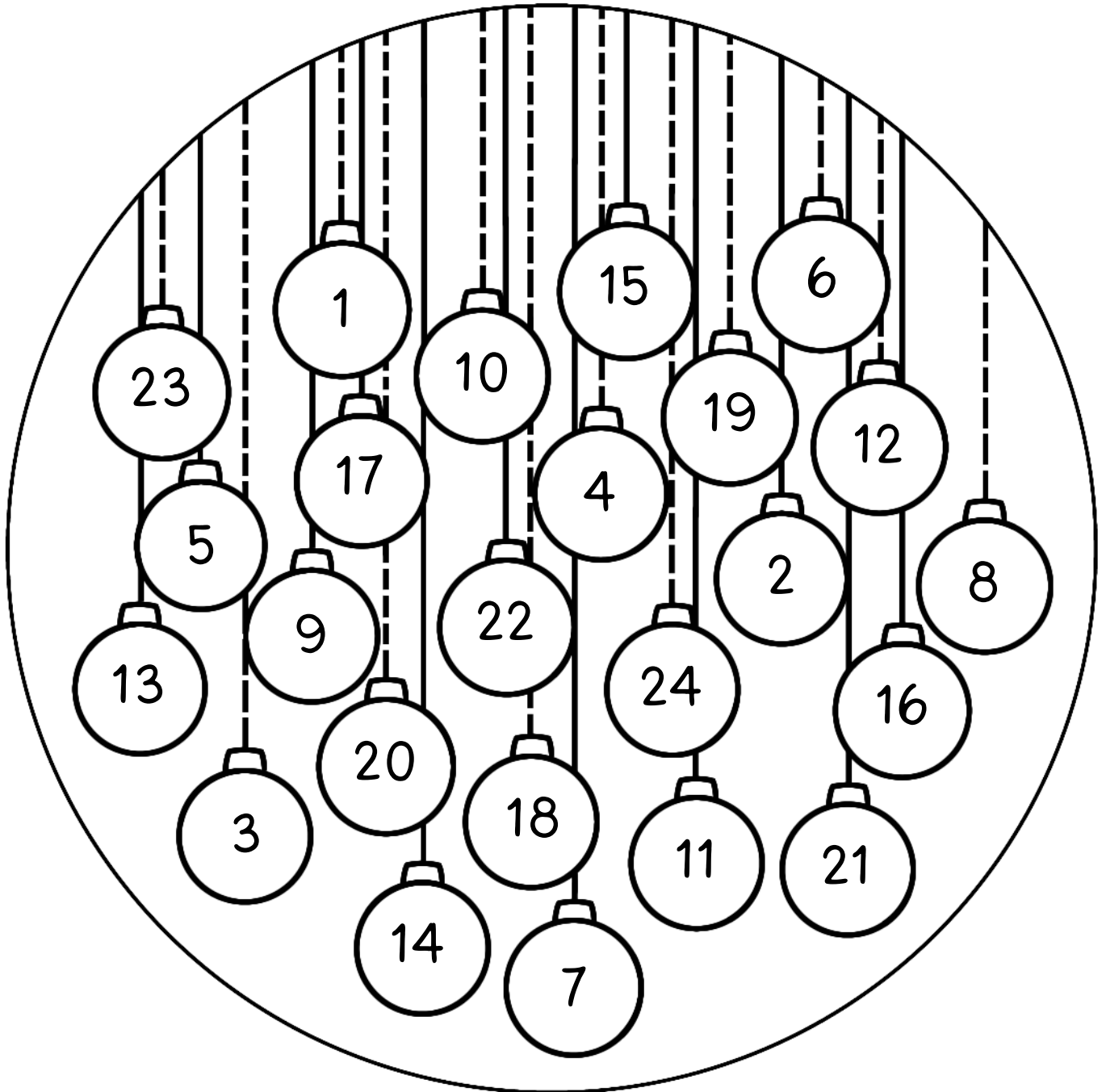
When printing your Pattern, please make sure you scale the printing settings to 100%.

So how do you get this design onto your fabric? There are several tools and materials that can be used for transferring designs onto your fabric. But the one I like to use is the tracing method. Print out the black and white design and using a fabric pen trace the design over a lightbox (you can use a window if you don't have a lightbox).
